The League for Animal Welfare can use dog or cat food, treats, paper towels, detergent, pet toys, Clorox, kitty litter, soft new bedding, soft cloth towels, pet shampoo, or any other pet items. Cash donations should be made payable to: The League for Animal Welfare. Both of these organizations are recognized charities and are fully deductible to the extent allowed by law.
