

What is Phising....Do you know?...

Phising occurs when cyber-criminals send out an official-looking email to individuals posing as



someone you know or from an organization you deal with asking you to forward info or money to them. (For example - Board members have received such emails from what looks like coming from the treasurer asking to send money to provided link and mention they will be reimbursed by the treasurer. Or in reverse, the treasurer receives an email asking them to make a payment on behalf of the chapter via the link provided.) Believe me, neither the Treasurer nor any officer would do that without personally taking to each other. So, if you ever receive this type of email, hover over their email address, as it tells who, then report and delete it - Never click on it!
